MACARY HOME REPAIR



These are two of three homes that were repaired in 2013, allowing the families to live in safe and more comfortable surroundings. Unfortunately, little help was provided from the community, and a carpenter was hired to do the repairs. Two of the owners are

ANIMAL HUSBANDRY -GOAT PROJECT IN MARO VERGER

HUMANITARIAN AID -SMALL BUSINESS INCENTIVE

This incentive was provided to assist Suzanne Paulo, the grand-aunt/ guardian of four orphans, Ralph, Sarah, Woodolph and Eldridge Orley Beauchamp, who are being assisted under our Child Sponsorship Program. Mrs. Paulo, an astute saleswoman, will use the incentive to help expand her



small business by buying more rice in l'Artibonite, beans and other products at a lower cost, and selling them when prices increase. The additional income would assist her as guardian and caregiver of these children. SCHOOL SUPPLIES DISTRIBUTION

CHRISTMAS MEAL DISTRIBUTION

A total of 1300 of our sisters and brothers, including 950 children, enjoyed Christmas meals at three localities, on December 25 in La Saline (suburban Port-au-Prince), on December 26 in Macary (south eastern Haiti) and Laboule 12



(suburban Pétionville), on December 28.

Each child was given a toy, many of them were contributed through a toy drive by 2 young children supporters in Miami

and Winnifred Vaval and Karol-Ann Zeny, in Haiti. At these large

gatherings, we take the opportunity to present health awareness sessions on current health challenges faced by residents. In La Saline and Laboule 12, Dental Hygienists Guillemettre Nikerson and Emerson Laforêt demonstrated proper teeth brushing techniques,



and the children were provided with tooth paste and tooth brushes. In Macary, Dr John Harbottle, provided information on cholera prevention and hygiene care.
